


#### STUDYING PLANTS THROUGH SKETCHING


After watching the <u>Plant Characteristics video</u>, head outdoors and find a plant you'd like to study and **sketch on your worksheet** (or on a piece of paper).

### LEAF EDGE



### **TIPS**

- Start with the **general shape** of the leaf you are sketching: is it a long oval? Or more like a triangle?
- Once you have a general shape and size,
  add the details you observe, such as the leaf edge and veins.
- Draw multiple sketches of the plant. You may add more than one leaf, buds or flowers, or sketch the entire plant.
- Add notes and labels to the sketch. What does the leaf feel like (fuzzy, smooth, rough)? What color is it? Are there bugs on it? What does it smell like?
